

Sir,

I am to refer to the above mentioned RTI application received from you and to say that on its perusal, it is seen that, you are seeking number of complaints received and action taken in the format attached with the RTI application on the offences mentioned in the format where the victim is a domestic worker from all states and Union Territories from 1st April, 2023 to 31st March, 2024.

- It is to clarify that the Commission neither register on any offence, nor it is required under any Law/Rules/Regulations to do so, but it registers complaints alleging violation of human rights. Further, the Commission does not categorize the victims, to identify the victim as domestic servant. As such the information sought in the RTI application is neither held by the Commission, nor the RTI Act cast any obligation upon CPIO to collect and provide the information, which is not the part of the record of the public authority.
- 3. The First Appeal, if any, against the reply of the CPIO may be made to the First Appellate Authority within 30 days of receipt of reply. The details of first appellate authority are as under:-
